The purpose of this memo is to advise details of the DRA Weekend, 6th and 7th of July 2019.

This year some major changes to the weekend have been made. We believe this will increase the prestige of the event and assist the development of the junior competition. We also have managed to reduce some of the cost to competitors by increasing the NSWRA subsidy of the event.

The **Junior Country/City Teams match** this year will be included with the Inter Schools Competition that is programmed to take place on the week of the 15-20th July. Further advice for this event will be sent to those that have already nominated for the respective teams.

In regards to all other competitions in order to ensure that we have enough targets/markers etc. it is essential that you advise this office as soon as possible of your nominations **and pay the appropriate fees** to the office no later than the advertised closing date.

City vs Country –

Two sighters and 10 shots to count @ 500m, 600m, 700m and 800m.

- Target Rifle –
 - Senior: 15 shooters & 3 coaches, and
 - Under 25: 10 shooters & 2 coaches.
- F Class –
 - F Standard – 10 shooters & 2 coaches
 - F Open – 8 shooters & 2 coaches.
 - F/TR – 4 shooters & 1 coach

The team's events will be subject to sufficient nominations being received for each discipline.

The District Associations Champion of Champions

Saturday 6th July 2019.

Muster on the mound at 8:00 am the match will commence at 8.30 am

Conditions:

- Two optional sighters and ten to count over 500m, 600m, 700m and 800m.
- Competitors to shoot shoulder to shoulder at the same time and in the same detail.
- The Under 25 Champion must be Under 25 years of age at the conclusion of their Club's competitive year in which the Club's championships are decided.
- The Under 18 Champion must be Under 18 years of age at the conclusion of their Club's competitive year in which the Club's championships are decided.
- The F Class competition requires at least 6 competitors in each category to constitute a match.

Ammunition:

Members are required to provide their own ammunition.

Entry Fee: \$40.00 (incl. GST) per shooter.

An indication of numbers of champions from each DRA is required by 10th June, 2019.

The District Association Combined Disciple Teams Match

This Match commences at 1.30 pm Saturday 6th July 2019.

Conditions:

- Two optional sighters & fifteen to count at 800 meter's.
- Open to teams consisting of:
 - Captain
 - 2 x Coach's
 - 8 x Shooters plus one reserve
- Members must come from the same District Rifle Association in NSW. Any DRA that has insufficient members to compete may call on the services of two members from another adjoining DRA in NSW.
- Metropolitan DRA's may enter three teams and Country DRA one team.
- Subject to availability of targets, additional entries may be allowed.
- Entries for all DRA teams will close 10th June, 2019.

Ammunition:

Members are required to provide their own ammunition.

Entry Fee: \$150.00 (incl. GST) per team.

Open Match Winner – Lamb Cup and NSWRA Gold Medals

DRA TEAMS ADVICE

This year an alternative DRA team completion is planned mainly due to many DRA's being unable to field full teams of the various disciplines, in addition time constraints have meant the day is rushed. The new competition, we believe will be fair to as well as provide an excellent competition for all disciplines to work together. Obviously the best team will comprise a mix of all disciplines.

We encourage you to try this new event, as we need to get as many competitors as possible to attend and enjoy this competitive weekend

General Conditions

- a) The time allowed for the match will be 180 minutes or determined by the CRO on the day to accommodate local conditions.
- b) Max range distance to be use i.e. 800m.
- c) One Stage of 15 shots plus two sighter's that may be converted.

Team Composition

- 1) Team to include; Captain, 2 x Coaches, 8 x shooting members and 1 x reserve
- 2) A team comprising all TR shooters will be permitted
- 3) Combined team members to comprise two TR then then a mix of members of FTR-FS-FO
TR Minimum of two TR are included in each the team. No Maximum Limit
FS/FO/FTR Any combination with a maximum of 3 of any one discipline
- 4) Up to two members may be "borrowed" from an adjoining Association if no other DRA members are present to compete
- 5) All scoring to be F class method i.e. 6 and X
- 6) Ties to be decided by the number of X's recorded or if unable to break the tie then by SSR's in regards to Team Tie break
- 7) Country DRA's are allowed one only Team. Additional teams however may be allowed if spare targets exist.
- 8) Metropolitan and North Shore allowed three teams each
- 9) Members may only compete in the one team.
- 10) Targets will be allocated on first come basis. Entries not to exceed the number of targets available
- 11) The reserve must be named before the match starts and can only be used in extenuating circumstance and only after approval is first obtained from the match director or Chief Range Officer
- 12) **All entry fees must accompany the entry form** and be paid before the Match commences
- 13) The time allowed for the match will be as per SSR's or determined by the CRO on the day to accommodate local conditions
- 14) Each team MUST provide a check scorer for the other team. They can be members of the team that are not shooting
- 15) The Match Director's decision will be final in regard to any change to the above conditions

Ammunition:

Members are required to provide their own ammunition.

Entry Fee:

\$375.00 (incl. GST) per Senior team. The Captain of each Senior team is responsible for collecting shooting fees at the commencement of the match.

Prize:

The Lieutenant Colonel E.A. Green Perpetual Shield, and NSWRA Gold medals will be awarded to each member of the winning team.

F CLASS STANDARD TEAMS

Conditions:

The Match will be fired in conjunction with the Country v City Teams Match with the same conditions.

Teams to consist of 10 shooters, plus 2 Coaches and a Captain.

Two optional sighters and ten to count over 500, 600, 700 and 800 metres.

- 2) The reserve must be named before the match starts and can only be used in extenuating circumstance and only after approval is first obtained from the Competition director or Chief Range Officer

Ammunition:

Members are required to provide their own ammunition.

Entry Fee:

\$250.00 (incl. GST) per F Class team. The Captain of each F Class team is responsible for collecting shooting fees at the commencement of the match.

Ammunition:

Members are required to provide their own ammunition.

Entry Fee:

\$150.00 (incl. GST) per F Class team. The Captain of each F Class team is responsible for collecting shooting fees at the commencement of the match.

Prize:

NSWRA gold medals will be awarded to each member of the winning team.
